Picture files are as follows:

Early years to reception/year 1

- Nouns File 1: Animals, people, play and toys
- Nouns File 2: Food, home, places, getting about (transport), weather
- Verbs (things we do) : Actions, everyday, sensory, talking...and more!
- Attributes: Colour, size, shape and quantity basics, number names (1 – 10)
- Attributes 2 and basic prepositions: Sensory (soft, hard, light dark etc), basic emotion (happy and not happy), prepositions

Primary

- Maths vocabulary: Size dimensions and associated words (height – tall/short, width – wide narrow etc), 2D shape names, 3D shape names, calculation words, basic mass and temperature vocabulary

Please read before placing your order. Payment of your invoice confirms that you have read and agree to these terms.

1. The training is the intellectual property of Dr Wendy Rinaldi, as are the books. The sale of Wendy's books and training are on condition that should you wish to help other schools or services to implement her resources, you will need written permission from Dr Rinaldi.
2. Delivery is with a next day courier service – your books will need to be signed for. Books are delivered on weekdays only in term time unless otherwise agreed
3. Books are printed to order on receipt of payment – you receive a proforma invoice on placing an order and when this is settled your books are printed and bound. If paying with school/authority cheque or electronic transfer you should allow up to 10 working days for delivery from receipt of payment. If paying by personal cheque please allow 25 working days from receipt of payment. Puppets are handmade to order and you will be advised of a delivery timescale by email when your order is received. 4. Payment can be made by cheque, made payable to Wendy Rinaldi, or by electronic transfer on written application by email to enquiries@wendyrinaldi.com. We can only accept payment in sterling. 5. As specialist materials, printed to order, books by Wendy Rinaldi are **not** refundable or returnable. We will help you as much as we can so that you are as sure as possible before your order and you can book a call with the author at orders@wendyrinaldi.com.
6. If your books are damaged in transit we will replace them if you contact us on the day of delivery. Please make sure you open your parcel as soon as you receive it.

APPROVED TRAINING

enable you to use without training but just about everyone says that the training sessions Wendy provides help them to get the most from the resources. You may have the opportunity to work alongside others who have used the previously, and this can be helpful, however it's recommend that you have some form of training with Wendy herself because, as author and founder, she can update you on the latest developments in terms of practice and research and you can check your understanding on how best to implement the resources with her. Further, sometimes Wendy trains staff who have been misinformed by feedback or 'cascading' perhaps from other members of staff who previously attended training – it can be a little like 'Chinese Whispers!' Sometimes staff share their own implementation of the and this may be different to how was conceptualised and also different to the implementation that has been researched and proven to be effective – so it's definitely worth having some time with Wendy, even if it's just a short online session. Having said that there's nothing like 'in person' training, so if your budget allows for the on an afternoon or short day training, described below, this is recommended. Alternatively, the practical study day (also described below) includes and there was excellent feedback on the day Wendy presented in Lincoln last year so she will be repeating it (with a few tweaks!) in different parts of the country - you can email to check if there's one coming up near to you.

Online introductory or 'check your understanding' session. Price £95

This is for two people, including a manager, as Wendy will help you to see how you can eventually use the programme to benefit all the pupils in the school as well as those who have special needs. She will guide you through the nuts and bolts of the programme and cover the elements that are important for effectiveness.

Words & Grammar in an afternoon: introduction and practical demonstrations from GGL, The Words Store & The Grammar Pack. Paired/trio training: Words & Grammar short day course. Price: £350 for two people; £490 for three.

All the 'Words & Grammar' short day courses are held at Wendy's office near Guildford Surrey. They include demonstrations from GGL, The Words Store and The Grammar Pack.

Practical Study Day: Social Communication, Social Understanding and Emotional Wellbeing

The practical study day consists of a series of practical lectures based upon Wendy's work as a therapist and researcher in education with children and teenagers. It is open to SENCos, specialist teachers, educational psychologists and speech-language therapists working with children at primary and secondary school who have special needs – from those with specific needs such as ASD or specific language/learning difficulties to those with more general learning difficulties. Some of the lectures are also open to nursery staff, teaching assistants and apprentices. Please note that teaching/therapy assistants and apprentices should attend with their SENCo or mentor/Speech-Language Therapist.

The lectures include illustrations from Wendy's published work together with ideas that teachers, health professionals and their assistants can use to develop their practice generally. Topics include social communication and social understanding; friendship; self esteem; emotional understanding and communication; inference; language organisation for getting your ideas and feelings across effectively. A final lecture looks at how to help children with special needs develop a better understanding of subjects such as Maths and Science. RELATED RESOURCES

If you are working with pupils from years 1 to 8, in a mainstream or special school setting, you may be interested in the schemes Get It and Get It Across: Maths & Science. These schemes provide a method of teaching that has enabled SEN pupils to understand and use Maths/Science concepts that they had previously struggled with when more conventional teaching methods were used.

The approach develops both semantic knowledge and pragmatic skills to enable pupils to understand concepts and communicate what they've learned.
